5. Third Thursday program

It was proposed and agreed that the REC will join the <u>Third Thursday Series</u>, a program of free, online events organized by the Gardiner, Marbletown, Rochester and Olive Environmental Conservation Commissions and hosted by Marbletown. Each month every third Thursday—the series presents a free, online program on an environmental topic of general interest to residents of Ulster County. 6. Other future events, and publicity
